

Directions to FBC from I-74

(not the shortest / fastest, but the easiest way to get to FBC without getting lost along the way...)

7 After taking the second road off the curve to the left, go about 1 to 2 miles.

Go up a steep hill. Go past the farm house at the top. Slow down--you're almost there.

Quickly after the farm house (1/4 to 1/2 mile),

there will be two "roads" on your right. Take the first road (this is the camp road). Go under the Faith Bible Camp sign and follow the road up and to the right (past the modular home) to the parking area. (Stay on the gravel if its been raining...) **YOU'VE MADE IT!!!**

6 Middle of curve has two roads... one to the right and one that seems to almost go straight... take the second one, the one that almost goes straight...

Bridge

5 At the T-stop in the middle of the curve, go right. The road will curve 90° to the right. Follow the curve. The road angles down over a bridge. Keep going about 2 to 3 miles. The road will curve 90° to the left.

4 another stop sign -- go straight.

3 The first stop sign you have to stop at is next to a picnic area. Do not turn here. Go straight at the stop sign and continue for about 3 to 4 more miles until you reach a T-intersection in the middle of a curve.



1a West of Brimfield (Knoxville, Galesburg, and beyond): Get on I-74 heading East until you get to exit 75.

- or -

1b East of Brimfield (Peoria, Bloomington, and beyond...): Get on I-74 heading West. Near Peoria, take the 474 bypass--about 2 to 3 miles on left after Morton Exits. About 10 miles on 474 until it joins 74 again. Stay left until 474 veers left to 74 West (to Galesburg). Once back on I-74 from I-474, keep following I-74 for about 15 miles until you come to Exit #75 (Brimfield / Oak Hill)... At the end of the exit, take a left. Go about two miles until you reach the stop sign at a T-intersection (Oak Hill).
